## 2022 Tours and Beyond

Over the past few weeks we have been receiving quite a few emails and calls by groups planning tours to Europe from the summer of 2022 until spring of 2023.

We have already booked group flight space for 4 tours for the fall of 2022. The feedback that we are getting is that while respecting Covid protocols, people are anxious to travel. As we approach these tour departures we will monitor Covid restrictions and protocols as they develop and to prepare accordingly.

## 2023 World Juniors In Russia

Unfortunately, we are cancelling our tour to Russia for the World Juniors mainly due to health concerns.

Only about one-third of Russians are fully vaccinated against the coronavirus. Public skepticism and mistrust about the efficacy and safety of domestically produced Russian vaccines have compounded the problem.

Russia has the highest COVID-19 mortality rate among countries in Europe and the second-highest rate in Asia, after India. There also seems to be a lack of transparency, inadequate testing in some parts of the country, and questions about the accuracy of their statistics.

Another primary concern is the possible issues with language should any of our passengers require medical attention.

We are very disappointed we will not be going to Russia but we think it is the right call for the safety of our passengers.

We already have plans for Sweden as per our tour webpage so hopefully a year from now we can start taking deposits for that tour. Those that have gone on our tours previously will get first opportunity to register followed by the new members of the Priority List.
