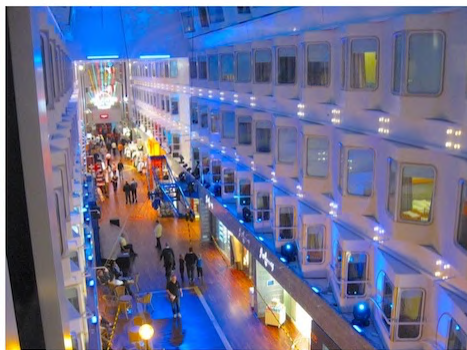
Meet at the Halifax airport and check in.

Your equipment and suit case will be on the bus in the locked cargo area.

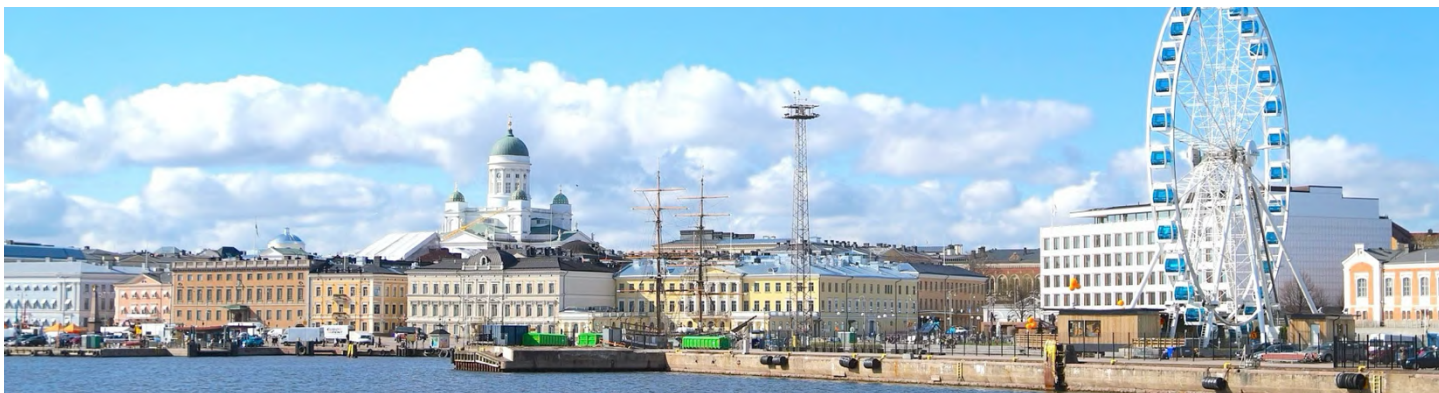

Today, it is a popular tourist destination with museums and other attractions and a living district of Helsinki with about 800 inhabitants.

Tallinn is Estonia's capital, a thriving hub of government, finance, and culture located on the Gulf of Finland. Known for its remarkably preserved medieval Old Town, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, the city features centuries-old architecture, a historical city wall and winding streets. It has a significant IT sector, a robust tourism industry, and a history as a key Hanseatic League trade center, evolving into a modern city since Estonia's independence from the Soviet Union in 1991.

Afternoon and evening free in Tallinn to sightsee shop and have lunch on your own

Get your tickets and board the Baltic Queen overnight ferry to Stockholm.

The Baltic Queen is a modern, luxury cruise ferry operated by Tallink Silja Line, primarily serving the Tallinn–Mariehamn–Stockholm route with passenger and vehicle transport. Built in 2009, the ship features a 1A Super ice class specification and offers a wide array of onboard amenities, including various restaurants, bars, nightclubs, saunas, shopping areas, and entertainment options like live shows and themed evenings.

The Baltic Queen's Grande Buffet offers a self-service dining experience with a broad selection of Nordic and international dishes, including hot and cold options, fresh salads, seafood, cheeses, and desserts. Prepared with seasonal ingredients, the buffet includes themed stations for grilling, a cold table, a "green market" for vegetarian dishes, warm main courses, and desserts. It also features drinks and caters to children and vegetarians, with specific vegan and kids' options available. Enjoy shows in the Starlight show lounge, live bands and DJs in the Sea Pub and nightclub, and live music at the Piano Bar.

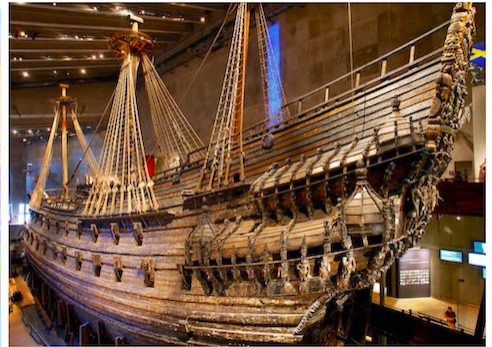

Guided bus and walking tour of Stockholm including the Vasa Ship Museum.

Stockholm is the capital and largest city of Sweden, a global center for culture, technology, and finance, built on 14 islands where Lake Mälaren meets the Baltic Sea. Founded in 1252, the city is known for its historic architecture in Gamla Stan (Old Town), as well as its innovation, earning it the title "Capital of Scandinavia". It's an important economic hub, the host of the Nobel Prize, and boasts a vibrant blend of historical charm and modern design.

The Vasa was a Swedish warship that sank in 1628 on its maiden voyage in Stockholm harbor due to instability, being too top-heavy and having insufficient ballast. Salvaged 333 years later in 1961, the ship is now a preserved time capsule and a popular museum attraction in Stockholm, offering unparalleled insights into 17th-century shipbuilding and life.

Depart for Royal Palace to take a guided tour of the palace.

The Stockholm Royal Palace is the official residence of the King and Queen of Sweden and serves as their daily workplace. Located in Stockholm's old town (Gamla Stan), it is a large, active Baroque-style palace with elements of the High Renaissance. The current palace was built in the 17th and 18th centuries after a fire destroyed the previous "Tre Kronor" castle, which dated back to the 13th century. It is one of the largest royal palaces in the world still in use for its original purpose, with over 600 rooms spread across eleven floors. Visitors can explore the State Apartments, the Royal Chapel, the Treasury, and the Tre Kronor Museum, and are often drawn to the popular changing of the guard ceremony.



The bus will drop you off on the island of Djurgården or in the city centre.

Djurgården is a forested island in central Stockholm, Sweden, famous for its blend of nature and culture, serving as a popular royal game park and now a national city park. Visitors enjoy attractions like the Vasa Museum, Gröna Lund amusement park, and the Skansen open-air museum, alongside extensive walking and cycling paths and harbors. Historically a royal hunting ground, it is now a major public recreation area and a popular tourist destination, attracting millions of visitors annually for its museums, cultural sites, and green spaces.
