Where Should I Exchange Money?

There are many little holes in the wall in Prague willing to exchange your money. Please note that they have a board with an exchange rate that is not always accurate. It may be the rate they sell money to you or they may have a minimum amount you need to exchange to get the posted rate. I always check approximately how much I should get back on an exchange app and I always ask how much I get back before I agree to the exchange.

One place that I usually go and it has a good reputation for giving people a "fair" exchange is EXCHANGE located a few steps from the St. Nicholas Church (big white church) in old town square at Kaprova 14/13. It's usually open from 9 am to 8 pm.
