



CANADA BEARS CUP - HOCKEY TOURNAMENT

The Canada Bears Cup is being organized to celebrate friendship in sport, and our love for the game of hockey with two guest teams from Denmark. The Danish teams are from **Rungsted Ishockey Klub** and the players are born in 2010 and 2011. They have an 'A' team that will play in the U15 AA Category and they have a "B" team that will play in the TIER 2 Category.

Canada Bears Cup - February 13-15, 2026

All games will be 15, 20, 20 minute stop time periods. Four games guaranteed for each team. Three round robin and one playoff game.

Tournament Round Robin Format

There will be 4 teams in each category and will play each other once in the round robin portion for 3 games total each. The top two teams will play for GOLD and the bottom two teams will play for BRONZE in each teams guaranteed a 4th game.

Warmup will be 3 minutes. Please bring your own warm up pucks.

There will be no tie games in the round robin.

A tied games will have a three minute 3 vs 3 sudden death overtime period.

If still tied, there will be a 3 player shootout.

If still tied, then it is a 1 per side shoot until a winner is declared.

One 30 second timeout for team.

Round Robin Point System and Tie-Breakers

Regulation Win – 3 points

OT or Shootout Win – 2 points

Ot or Shootout loss – 1 point

Regulation Loss – 0 points

Points tie breakers are as follows:

1. Game between the two teams (only if 2 teams are tied)
2. Most regulation time wins
3. Most regulation and overtime wins
4. Best GF minus GA ratio (regulation and OT goals only)

5. Most goals scored (regulation and OT only)
6. Most first goals of the game scored
7. Least penalty minutes
8. Coin Toss

Tournament Finals Format

The top 2 teams in each category will meet in the GOLD medal game and the bottom 2 teams will meet in the BRONZE medal game.

A tied games will have a three minute 3 vs 3 sudden death overtime period.

If still tied, there will be a 3 player shootout.

If still tied, then it is a 1 per side shoot until a winner is declared.

One 30 second timeout for team.

Tournament Awards

Every game we will have a player of the game award and all players will receive a tournament medal after their 4th game. Coaches will let a referee at the end of each game who their player of the game is.

Penalty Boxes

Each team must supply a person to work their team's penalty box each game.

When you face a Danish team you must supply two penalty box people.

Tournament Rules and Discipline

The tournament will be played with Hockey Alberta rules including for decisions on discipline. Any discipline will be adjudicated by the tournament committee headed by Bruce Fitzpatrick 587-385-7473 bruce@kchockey.ca

Games Involving Danish Teams – ONLY!

Teams will be asked to line up on the blue lines and we will play the Danish and the Canadian anthems. After the anthems the captain or each team will meet at the referees by the penalty box to shake hands and exchange any banner or gifts.
